# Program Aim

Enriching students' **language learning experiences** by leveraging the power of **storytelling as a pedagogical tool** along with the **newer possibilities that the digital medium** offers

# Program Objectives

- Strengthen language **teachers' capacities to create and utilize contextual digital resources** for addressing the **language learning needs of their students**
- Help teachers **experience and internalize technology integration** strengthening their technology, pedagogy and content knowledge (TPCK)
- Develop teachers' abilities to **use inclusive, constructivist and multilingual pedagogies in language teaching** to help students acquire competencies in languages taught in the school
- Facilitate setting up of **teachers Communities of Practice (CoPs)** that can promote **peer learning and mentoring** and enable continuous professional development (CPD)
- Make available all resources created by teachers on an **Open Educational Resource (OER) repository** for easy and universal access

# Program Summary

During 2023-24, the focus was primarily on **building capacities of teachers to create audio resources.**

In collaboration with the Colleges of Teacher Education (CTEs) in **Mysuru,**

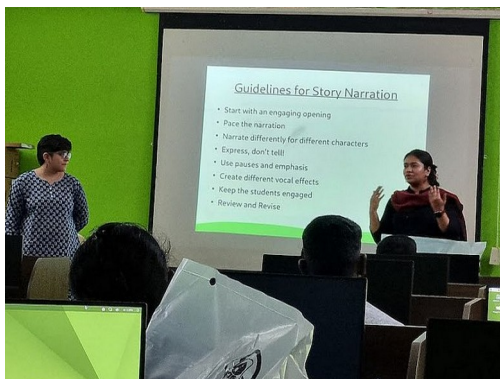

Further building the audio story repository through collaboration with DIETs in addition to CTEs

Enabling classroom level implementation by conducting workshops on techno-pedagogical aspects

Intensive engagement with select schools and teachers to get in depth understanding of actual classroom level implementation and challenges

Exploratory research about models of adoption by teachers in different contexts to understand possibilities and challenges



# Techno-Pedagogy Workshop

## Objectives:

- To help teachers experience and understand the ways in which audio stories can support language teaching-learning
- To understand how multilingual, inclusive and innovative teaching strategies can be used in language teaching
- To discuss different types of classroom activities that can be done using mobile-based audio stories
- To explore how story-pedagogy can help build listening and speaking skills in children



# Techno-Pedagogy Workshop

## Expected outcomes:

- Enhancement of teachers understanding of storytelling as pedagogy
- Teachers reflect on their beliefs and practices related to English Language Teaching
- Teachers experience and understand the potential of audio stories for English language learning
- Teachers explore strategies to develop effective listening to support language acquisition
- Gain familiarity and comfort with using AntennaPod for integrating audio stories in teaching-learning
- Develop an implementation plan for their classroom
