# Audio Story-based pedagogy for English Language Teaching-Learning


## **Workshop Objectives**

- Experience pedagogical possibilities of integrating audio stories in the English teaching-learning process
- Explore different technologies like AI and other tools that can be utilized to create digital resources that can be relevant and meaningful for the English classroom
- Exploring strategies to develop effective listening to support language acquisition
- To explore an audio story repository, Kathe Khajane on the AntennaPod mobile app
- Strengthen language teachers' capacities to create and utilize contextual digital resources for addressing the language learning needs of their students

## **Explorations in Karnataka**

- State-wide teacher professional development program initiated in 2023-24 together with the Karnataka Education Department
- Designed to help teachers explore the powerful role that audio stories can play in enhancing language learning
- Delved into critical techno-pedagogical concepts, rooted in educational frameworks
- An outcome of the project is the development of *Kathe Khajane* ("*Treasure pot of Stories*") which has **over 200 stories recorded and produced by government higher primary school teachers** in 4 languages published on the Free and Open Source App, AntennaPod

Intensive engagement with select schools and teachers to get in depth understanding of actual classroom level implementation and challenges
